Document List For Consultation

- Please <u>WRITE</u> or <u>TYPE</u> out a complete list of <u>ALL</u> debts including:
 - name of creditor
 - address of creditor
 - account number
 - balance owed

(List ALL debts even if you want to keep paying- including home, vehicle, child support/alimony, taxes, etc. We <u>do not</u> accept credit reports, but can serve as a good guideline for assembling your creditor list. Bill statements are also <u>not</u> <u>preferred</u>, but, again, can serve as a good guideline.)

- Please provide pay stubs for the last <u>6 full months plus any received this month</u> or a printout of your pay history from your employer. (If you are married we need this payroll information for your spouse also even if your spouse is not going to file – we need to prepare a summary of all household income)
- <u>If you are receiving Social Security</u> we will need a copy of your yearly statement.
- <u>If you are self-employed or own a business</u>, please provide a profit & loss statement for the last <u>6 full months plus this month.</u>
- <u>If you have a child support or alimony debt</u>, or anything else pertaining to a divorce decree, please bring the court order and the name, address, and phone number for the person who receives the payment.
- <u>If you have a loan against a retirement plan</u>, please bring the loan documents. The court will need to know the loan amount, the payment amount, and when the loan will be finished.
- Last 3 tax returns. (including W-2 and 1099 forms)
- Copy of county tax bill if buying or owning land.
- Bank statements for all accounts for the last 90 days.
